

#### Why support <u>Cromehurst</u>?

The <u>Cromehurst</u> Foundation is a registered charity providing essential facilities, resources and programs for children and adults with an intellectual disability, including those with high support needs who attend or have previously attended the government special school <u>Cromehurst</u> School.

One of the essential facilities is an independent living skills program conducted in The Cottage. Past and present students of <u>Cromehurst</u> School live in during the week and learn many of the skills essential for daily living, such as cooking, cleaning, shopping skills and personal care as a complement to their school programs. This program provides a much needed resource and social avenue for children and adults with intellectual disabilities as well as supporting <u>Cromehurst</u> School.

Cromehurst School supports students with moderate and severe intellectual disabilities. Many of the students have additional disabilities including Autism along with physical and sensory disabilities. The school supports students from 4 years of age until the completion of year 12 usually at 18 years of age. The NSW curriculum is taught with adjustments according to the student's individual needs and students follow a life skills pattern of study to receive a quality education and a High School Certificate at the completion of year 12.

The school focuses on increasing students' independence and communication skills to empower them to make life choices, build social relationships and enrich their community. The Cromehurst Foundation and Cromehurst School recognise the importance of community spirit and believe education is built on the successful partnership between school and families. Planning for post school commences as early as possible and collaboration between the school and the Foundation's cottage program is an essential part of preparing many of our students for life beyond school.

In addition the Foundation has provided funding to purchase resources for students which enable the delivery of individualised education programs and the development of essential life skills for maximum independence as they move to adulthood. Previously this has included technology, classroom resources, playground equipment and a specialised vehicle for transporting students.

The Foundation receives no government funding and each year the Foundation and Cromehurst School hold a golf day and charity auction dinner to raise the funds necessary to maintain and enhance learning opportunities for both current and past students of Cromehurst School. This is our major fundraiser for the year. The next Golf Day will be held at Roseville Golf Club on Wednesday 29th March, 2017. We rely on corporate sponsorship and donations for the success of the day which enable these vital programs to continue.
