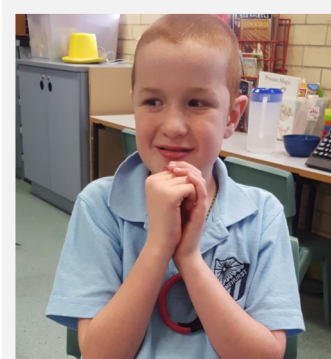
Yellow Class

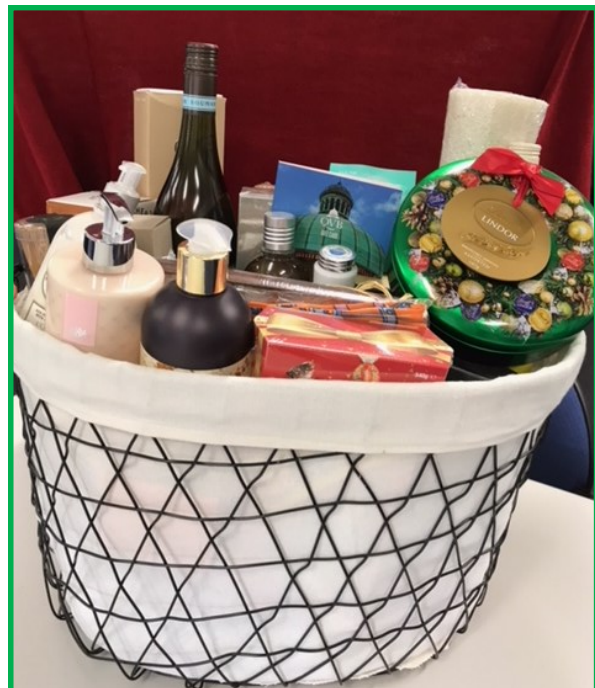
