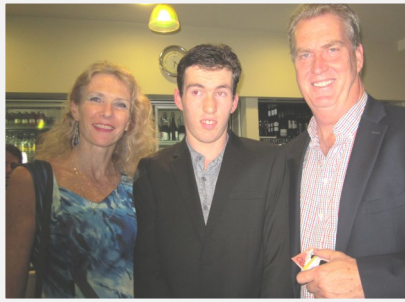




# Graduation & Secondary Social Event

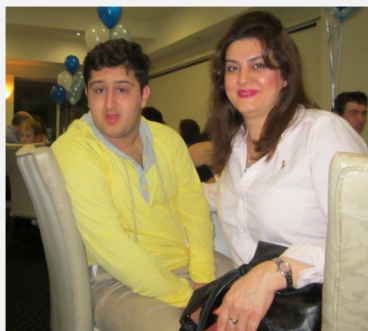

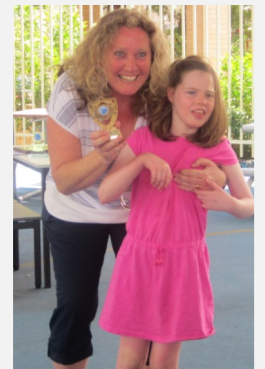

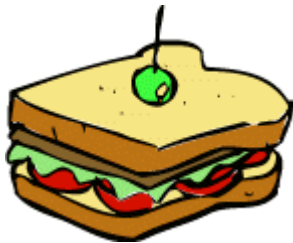
