### Pink Class

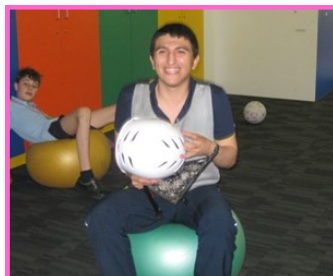

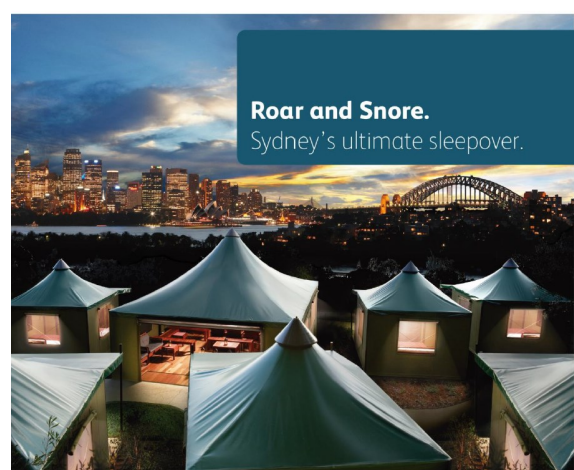
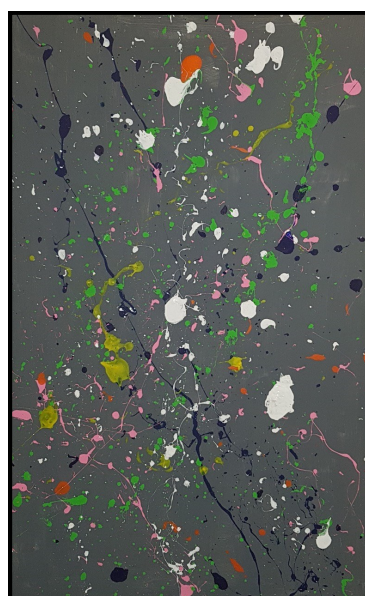
# Cromehurst Charity Night

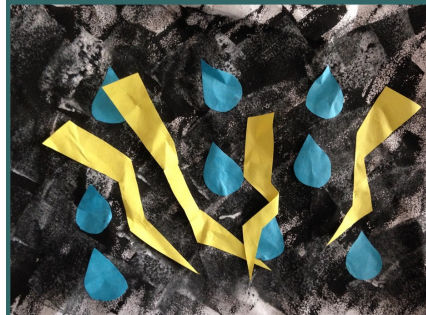

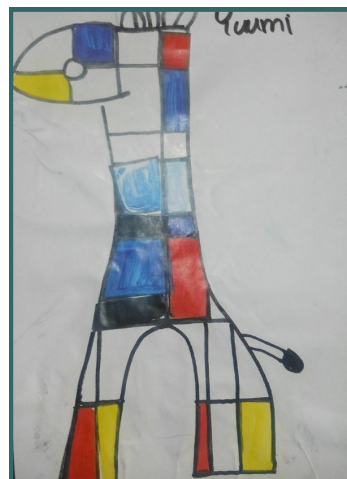
## Primary Art News

The primary students have been working on the theme of 'The Weather' this term and by using a variety of materials they have so far created rainbows, storms and umbrellas.



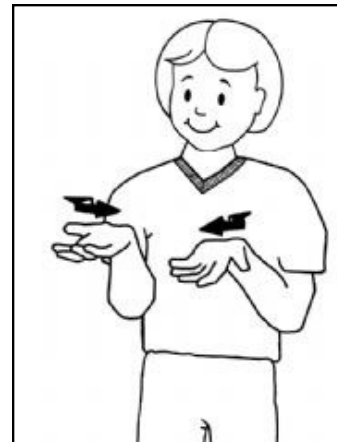
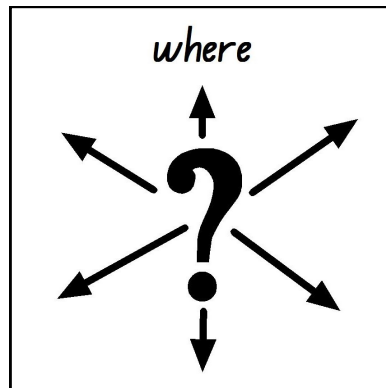
## Secondary Art News

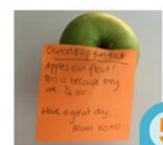
