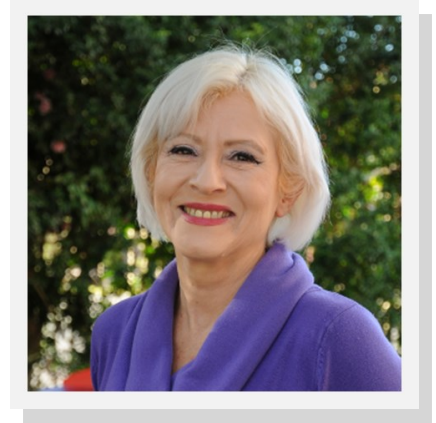
Last week we emailed information regarding Unisson's

- keep up-to-date with the latest health information by monitoring the [NSW Government website](#) external link.

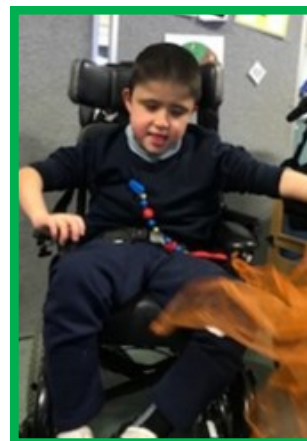
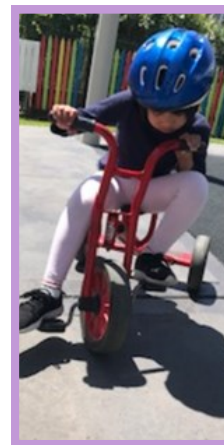
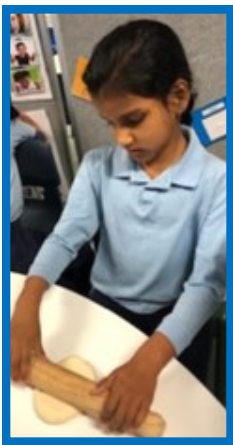
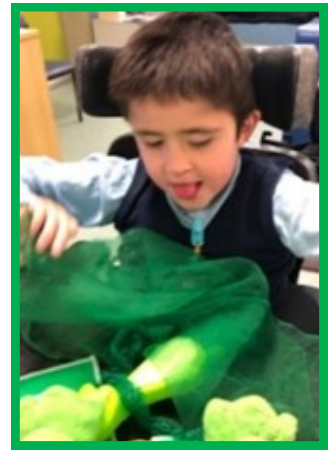

Rainbow Class

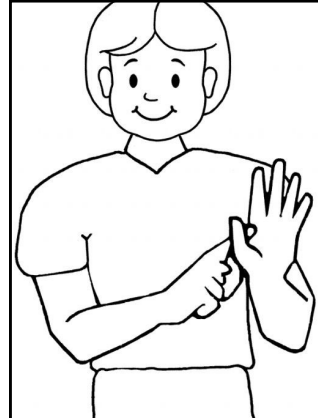
