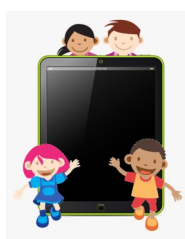


Cromehurst P&C and Variety The Children's Charity






Sign 'm', followed by 'day'.
