In our communication lessons this term we are focussing on what it means to be a **FRIEND**. The students have been considering the questions: what is a friend and how do friends make you feel? The students have been working on identifying their friends and looking at them to greet them. They have also been working on asking their friends questions and listening carefully to their answers so they can get to know more about them. The students have used the smart whiteboards, visuals, switches and Proloquo2Go on the iPad to aid communication where needed.



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Principal's Message

Welcome to week five.

Once again thank you for your continuing efforts in supporting our school and students during the pandemic assisting us to prioritise safety and learning. A reminder that the additional restrictions imposed last week continue this week and until 1 June. These restrictions have been imposed following advice from the Department of Education's Health & Safety Directorate due to increasing levels of school-based transmission of COVID-19. This means that all meetings will need to be virtual during this time, we return to cohort groups and all programs involving the presence of students from other schools are again on hold during this period. I have included another copy of the note sent home last week with further information.



Additionally, in line with the latest update to advice from NSW Health, if a staff member or student is still displaying symptoms on day seven of their isolation period, they need to remain in isolation until 24 hours after their symptoms have resolved. If symptoms persist, NSW Health advise that individuals should consult a GP, who will be able to provide further support related to individual circumstances. It is also essential that if your child is displaying symptoms of any kind regardless of a negative COVID test they should not attend school until all symptoms have resolved. We are currently operating with reduced staff levels on some days due to a range of illnesses and like all schools are experiencing extreme difficulties in replacing unwell staff and many students have also been ill with non-COVID viruses. We are attempting to cease the spread of all viruses in our school so thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

This week we are focusing on our communication program conducted via team teaching across the school. Although the program has been interrupted at times due to staffing shortages mentioned previously the program has continued to run in an adjusted format by the class teacher. The photo gallery included demonstrates our students engaging in specific lessons to enhance communication linked to their individual educational programs.

I have included information regarding an on-line presentation focused on improving Support Coordination for NDIS participants. The presentations are scheduled for several dates with times both during the day and in the evening. Information will include but not be limited to

- what we have heard about how support coordination can work better
- what participants should expect from their support coordinator
- how we will improve support coordination for participants.

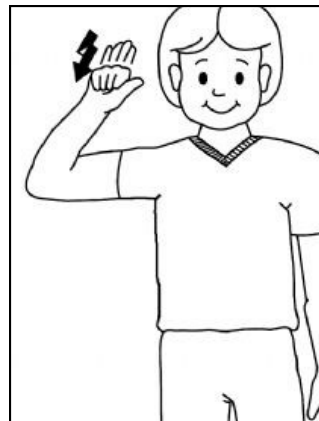

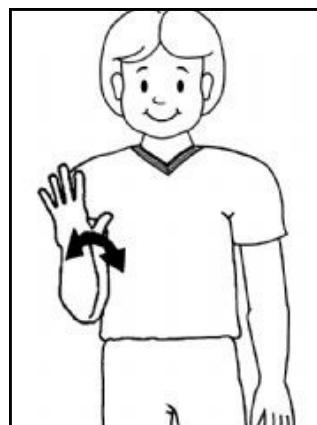
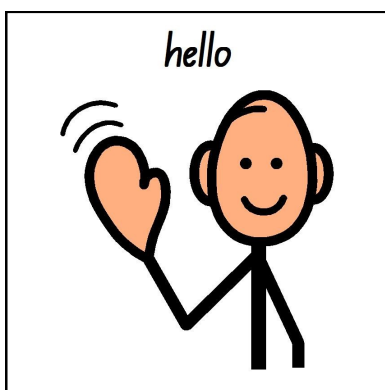

Dear Parents,

A big thank you for your continuing efforts in supporting our school and students during the pandemic – especially prioritising safety and learning.

Recently our school community has been experiencing increasing levels of COVID-19 exposure and transmission. To minimise disruption to face-to-face learning and reduce in-school transmission of COVID-19, our school has been working closely with the Department of Education's Health & Safety case management team and has decided to temporarily adopt some additional COVID-smart measures for the next two weeks.

These temporary measures are designed to act as a "circuit breaker" to reduce transmission of COVID-19 in our school.

From **17 May**, our school will adopt the following enhanced settings:

- Cohorting of class groups
- Physical distancing of at least 1.5 metres will be encouraged for all school staff
- Large indoor gatherings will be rescheduled to a later date or held in out settings if possible. This includes in door assemblies and events.
- Masks will be required for all school staff and visitors.
- Non-essential activities will be postponed

After two weeks, our school will work with the department to determine whether an extension is required or if we can revert to our usual layered COVID-smart measures. Once this decision is made we will communicate this to you.

Our continued layered measures include:

- Students, staff and visitors must stay home and test if sick. Refer to Advice for families for more information on testing and reporting a positive RAT.
- Maximising ventilation and distancing when practicable.
- Enhanced daily cleaning.
- Focus on personal hygiene.
- All school staff are required to be double vaccinated against COVID-19.
- All students are encouraged to get the COVID-19 vaccine.
- Masks required for staff working in SSPs and support classes.

Additionally, in line with the latest update to advice from NSW Health, if a staff member or student is still displaying symptoms on day 7 of their isolation period, they need to remain in isolation until 24 hours after their symptoms have resolved. If symptoms persist, NSW Health advise that individuals should consult a GP, who will be able to provide further support related to individual circumstances.

We strongly encourage our students and their families to consider vaccination, including boosters when eligible. Find a [vaccination clinic](#) to book an appointment near you.
