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Principal's Message

Welcome to week seven.

As I informed you last week we have been able to lift the additional restrictions imposed due to high numbers of COVID cases transmitted at school. This means that cross age learning groups, integration programs and school assemblies can recommence in a COVID safe manner. We will be maintaining the use of masks at all times and the vaccination mandate and close contact rules still apply in all Special Schools. If a member of



your household tests positive you need to inform Service NSW (if tested on a RAT) and the school. If your child tests positive to COVID they must isolate for seven days from their positive test. Additionally, in line with the latest update to advice from NSW Health, if a staff member or student is still displaying symptoms on day 7 of their isolation period, they need to remain in isolation until 24 hours after their symptoms have resolved. If symptoms persist, NSW Health advise that individuals should consult a GP, who will be able to provide further support related to individual circumstances.

Tomorrow, 7 June is our school photo day. Photos will commence at 9:00am and will commence with a whole school photo followed by class and individual photos. Please ensure that your child is at school by 9:00am tomorrow if you wish your child to be in the first whole school photo. If possible, please also ensure that they are wearing school uniform or at least the colours of our school (light blue and navy blue). If you wish to order photos but have not yet returned the order form please do so tomorrow and notify the school via School Stream or email before 8:30am.

Last Friday I sent you a note regarding the industrial action for Public Service Association members on 8 June. The PSA includes SLSOs, office staff and General Assistants and unlike mainstream schools constitute a significant amount of our school workforce and are essential in maintaining the health and safety of our students. The information provided to me in regard to the number of members participating has meant that I have determined, in consultation with the Director, Educational Leadership that there will be insufficient supervision to ensure the safety needs of all students and staff. Therefore, Cromehurst School will be non-operational on Wednesday, 8 June and families will need to make alternative arrangements for their children on this day. A separate note confirming this was sent to parents this morning.

Student reports will be sent home in the week beginning 27 June. We have been working on a changed reporting format to more accurately reflect student progress which has been drafted for both the Individual Education Program (IEP) and Individual Transition Program (ITP) and the class programs. For this report we will be using the new format for IEP/ITPs only as we are still making adjustments to the class program format. We would appreciate any feedback you have on the newer format and will consider any comments or suggestions as we move forward.

Finally the next meeting of our P&C will be this Friday, 10 June which will include the Annual General Meeting which must be held face to face. The meeting will be held at 9.30am at TheRunaway Spoon Cafe (near the school) due to the COVID safe measures required for the meeting to occur on site. All parents are welcome and the note later in this edition outlines the procedures for becoming a member of the P&C.

I hope all of our families have a relaxing (and not too cold) three day break this long weekend. We have all earned it.

Visual supports have also been introduced to aid instructing students when to start and stop playing their instrument parts as a group. 


