Aqua Class

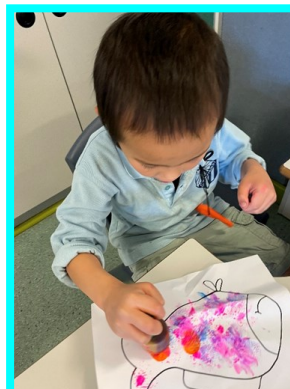
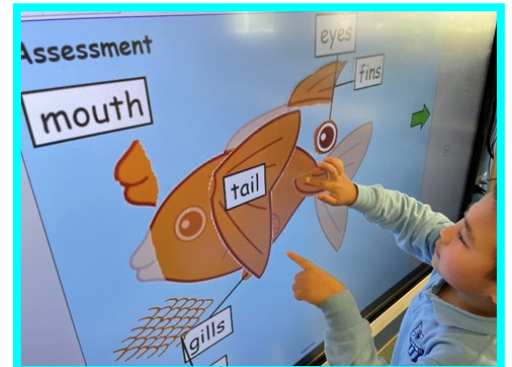
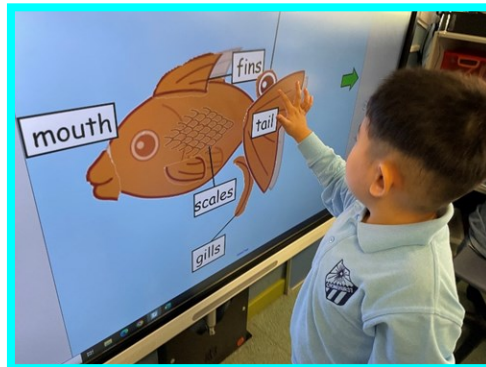

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Principal's Message

Welcome to week eight.

Last Tuesday was our annual school photo day and despite the very cold windy weather the rain held off and we were able to complete all school, class and individual photos. With much effort we managed a whole school photo featuring all students and staff who were present at 9:00am, apologies to those families whose children were late to school that day but sitting all students for a photo shoot is a huge undertaking and as you know our students do not sit and wait easily, late students still were included in their class and individual photo shoots.



You will notice that in the class photos staff were not wearing masks, they wore them up until the photographer gave the signal to remove them before taking the photo. This was not possible in the whole school photo so you will note all staff kept their masks on for this photo. It will remind us all what a crazy year this has been for everyone.

The flyers appearing later outline events for the Hornsby Waitara Community Hub (which offers a range of free, flexible and innovative programs for families of young children aged 0-5). The Community Hub aims to build programs that support families, parents and foster cooperation and positive relationships with local services and organisations. A Free Triple P Parenting Program is available which aims to provide practical answers to everyday parenting concerns in the areas of:

- Promoting your child's development & communication skills;
- Managing your child's behaviour & emotions;
- Building a good relationship with your child.

This program is available in both English and Mandarin, dates and details in the flyers attached.

As we move into winter, NSW Health and the Department of Education would like to remind all parents, carers and the school community that now is the best time to protect your children against viral illnesses such as the flu and COVID-19 by staying home if unwell and getting vaccinated. We urge all parents and carers to please keep your children at home even if they are unwell with even the mildest symptoms. Remember to use a rapid antigen test if your child is experiencing even mild COVID-19 symptoms and keep them home until they are well and free of any symptoms, even if their result is negative. If your child's RAT result is positive, it must be reported through the Service NSW website or Service NSW app.

Flu and COVID-19 can be serious illnesses, even in children and teenagers. Both viruses can spread quickly when large numbers of people are in close contact, such as at school. More people of all ages will be at risk this winter with international borders reopening, increased social mixing and lower exposure to flu over the past two years. Both the flu and COVID-19 are already circulating in the community, so it's important to protect yourself and your family. We are currently experiencing slightly lower incidents of COVID but an increase in non-COVID illnesses including the flu in our school.

Flu vaccines are free for all NSW residents aged 6 months and older in the month of June, as part of the NSW Government's effort to combat this year's expected severe influenza season. We strongly recommend that families take advantage of this opportunity. Vaccinations are available through GPs and pharmacies, and can be safely received at the same time as a COVID-19 vaccination.

The COVID-19 vaccination remains a recommendation for everyone aged 5 years and over, and is also available through GPs and pharmacies.

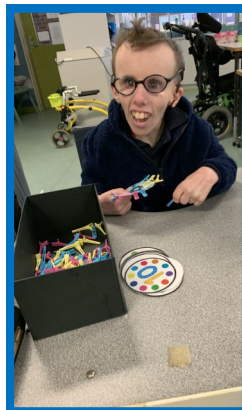
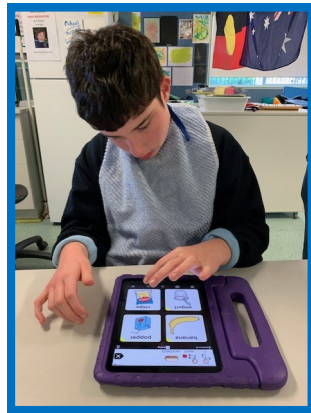

This newsletter piece for Blue Class is an award for the whole class for their excellent work this term. We have been blown away by their progress in the 3 key areas below.

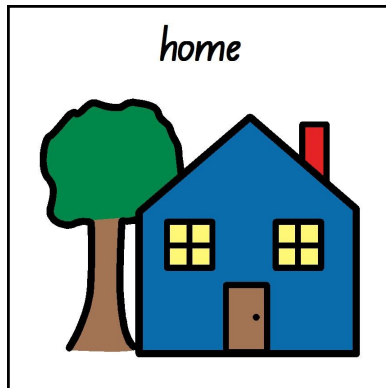

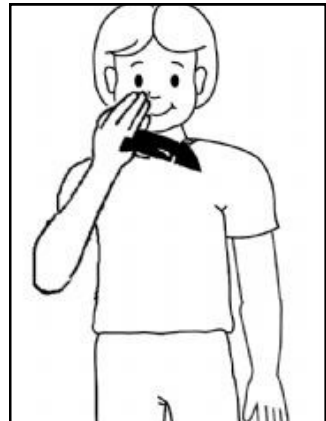
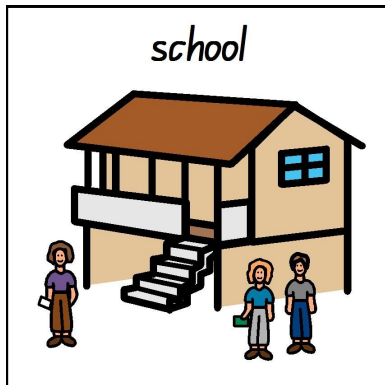
