Principal's Message

Welcome to 2023.

I hope all of our families had some quality time together and enjoyed a break from the school routine. This term we welcome some new families to our school community with new students to our school. Welcome to Kaira, Hudson and James in Aqua class, DeAngelo in White class, Elliot in Green class, Cooper in Purple class, Sean in Blue class and Ruiqi in Red class. All of our students have settled well in their new classes and are happily engaged in all learning activities.



We are conducting parent information evenings on 15 March and 16 March - 15 March is for families of primary students and 16 March is for families of secondary students. This meeting will outline the focus and programs for your child this year and enable parents to connect with other families. Two evenings have been organised to accommodate social distancing as per the Department of Education's guidelines for events and gatherings. In line with that we have been informed by the Department that COVID-smart measures are to continue this term and have been provided with the following advice.

"While the community continues to transition towards living with COVID-19, NSW Health advise that the unpredictable nature of the virus will continue to present a health risk to the community, with new waves of transmission expected in 2023.

In line with the health advice and community settings, the department will continue implementing baseline COVID-smart measures in schools throughout Term 1 which includes the following:

- *Reminding students, staff and families to stay home if unwell and test for COVID-19 if showing any symptoms*
- *Boosted day cleaning of high touch areas in our schools*
- *Requiring masks for staff and volunteers who interact with students at greater risk of serious illness if they were to contract COVID-19 – including in SSPs, support units and some mainstream settings*
- *Strongly encouraging up-to-date vaccinations for our staff and students, including COVID-19 booster shots for anyone eligible*

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Principal's Message (continued)

- *Maintaining natural ventilation with windows and doors open whenever possible, including when cooling/heating systems are in use*
- *Staff working in, or visiting, SSPs, who are required to be double vaccinated with an approved COVID-19 vaccine (or hold a valid medical contraindication)*
- *Outside of school hours, off-site or non-curriculum activities require additional parental consent and stronger COVID-safe advice*

While schools may continue to host gatherings onsite, consider the following:

- *Holding the gathering outdoors or in well-ventilated venues.*
- *If holding an event indoors:*
 - *consider separating your students into cohorts and encourage physical distancing where practicable*
 - *consider seating plans or separated areas to minimise mingling*
 - *limit the number of guests attending where possible*
 - *provide hygiene supplies (such as sanitiser and masks) and encourage use*
 - *masks are strongly encouraged for students, staff and visitors.*

I have also included a flyer regarding an NDIS networking event this Wednesday for any interested families.

Finally, a reminder that if you need to communicate an important message to your child's teacher during the day please contact the office for it to be passed on. Teachers are not able to check emails whilst they are teaching or on playground duty. Our School Stream app can be used to send an email to the office to pass on via the contact button or you can call the school.

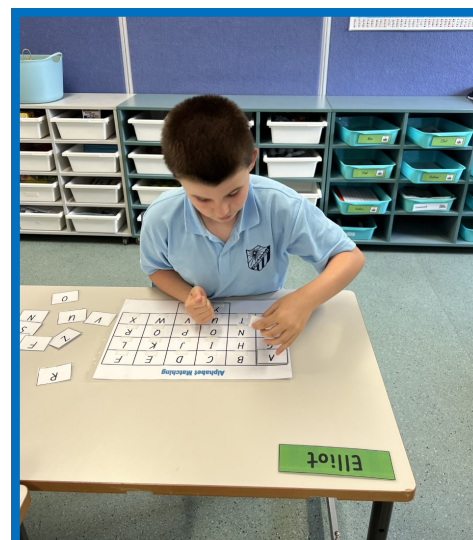
