






























# Cromehurst Art Show

Cromehurst School provides a comprehensive and specialised education for students from Kindergarten to Year 12.


In great news, Cromehurst School will have two students graduating Year 12 in 2024. This is a great testimony both to the work ethic, commitment and dedication by the students and teachers.
